What is the Difference between the ACT and the SAT?

The ACT and the SAT are both college entrance tests; however, there are some significant differences:

- The ACT is a content based test and measures what you have learned in school. The ACT tests your knowledge of English, Math, Reading, and Science. The ACT is a three hour test scored based upon the number of correct answers. There is no penalty for guessing on the ACT. ACT tests are scored on a scale of 1-36 points each with the overall maximum possible composite score (not including the essay) of 36.
- The SAT is a critical thinking and problem solving test. The SAT tests your Writing, Math and Critical Reading skills. The SAT is a three hour and forty-five minute test scored based upon the number of correct answers adjusted for guessing. That means there is a penalty for guessing on the SAT, if your answer is not correct. The SAT tests are scored by section on a scale of 200-800 up to a maximum score of 2400.
