

THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

1. Must be eligible for ACCESS Last Dollar Scholarship.
2. Applicant must be a female high school senior pursuing a construction-related degree program.
3. Applicant must desire a career in a construction-related field.
4. Applicant must plan to be enrolled full-time; part-time students are not eligible for awards.
5. Applicants must have a current cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher to be considered for awards.
6. Recipients and guest or representative will be requested to attend NAWIC's September Industry Appreciation Night, on September 16, 2009.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items listed below are submitted to the ACCESS Advisor at your school by May 26, 2009. Please attach in the order shown:

- A. Completed and signed application form.
- B. Official transcript of grades for three most recent quarters/semesters.
- C. Extracurricular Activities listing.
- D. Employment History listing.
- E. Any additional letters of recommendation.

AWARDS

- A. Scholarships are not automatically renewed, but recipients will be considered for subsequent awards of the NAWIC Founders Scholarship if they provide evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, and continued enrollment and good standing in a college program leading to a degree in a construction-related field.
- B. The application process must be completed for each year that you wish to be considered for awards.
- C. Applications shall be reviewed and winners selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Greater Tidewater Chapter #137 of the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC), which will consider applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, evaluations and financial need. All applicants will be notified of their status after the Scholarship Committee meeting.
- D. Applicants may be asked for a personal interview with a representative of the NAWIC Scholarship Committee. All award recipients will be notified of their status after evaluations are complete, usually in May or June.
- E. Checks will be sent directly to the school no later than August preceding the school term upon presentation of matriculation information for the next school term and other information as designated by the Committee.

SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION

All applications, with supporting material, must be submitted to the ACCESS Advisor at your school by May 26, 2009.
